Director's Corner

A few quick friendly reminders to everyone —

Drop off/Pick Up — Please, **no cell phone use** during this time. We need your full attention—we need to ensure you're aware when your child has been released to you directly, or if we need to speak to you, you're easily available,

We wanted to also mention that **ALL** children should be in center and ready to start their days by no later than 9 AM unless absolutely necessary (i.e.: Doctor/Other appts, etc.) Anything after 9 AM interrupts the classroom day/learning time, requires changes meal counts, etc. If your child will be later than 9 or absent, we ask you to call or email before 9 to either the office or the classroom to let us know.

MASKS and COVID— The CDC Board decided on Monday, June 28th that as of now, parents may choose to not wear a mask in the church lobby at pick-up/drop off, However, at this time we will continue to follow COVID protocols initially put into place until the end of the Summer session. This means we will still do temperature checks, hand washing and sanitizing for children before entry and no visitors /parents will be allowed past the lobby. The Board felt it was in the best interest of the children. At the end of the Summer Session the Board Policy will be reviewed and they will decide upon any revisions or modifications. We also kindly ask that when you are here that you enter the building/wait inside the Narthex/Lobby for your child to be delivered. We need to release the children to you or your proxy directly and are not permitted to "send children out" unattended.

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS

Extra clothing- If you have not already, Please be sure to bring a seasonal change of clothing for the summer time to be left in the classroom.

Footwear- For safety while playing outdoors we ask you please send your children in close toed and heeled shoes.
