Our Commitment to Health & Safety

Providing a healthy and safe learning environment for the children is the highest of priorities. In addition to following our center's comprehensive health and safety protocols, we regularly adjust our operations to meet or exceed the current guidance from local and state health departments during this time of heightened vigilance. We are currently doing this by following these safety measures:

- Repeated disinfecting/cleaning of “high-touch” surfaces throughout the school day and in the evenings (including desks, doors, public spaces, and bathroom fixtures)
- Frequent and thorough hand-washing by students and team, actively encouraged throughout the school day
- Finally, wearing facial masks/coverings as required
